- All submissions should be in Times New Roman font, size 12, following the MLA 9th edition (for Humanities) or APA 7th edition (for Social Sciences) citation style, and in Word format.
- Please ensure that your file name is in the format: fullname_ETH_abstract (for Humanities) and fullname_ETSS_abstract (Social Sciences). The same applies to the subject of the mail. Submissions should be mailed to hss.conf@gmail.com

Full paper submission:

- Selected abstracts will be notified to submit full papers. Papers should be about 5000 words, in Times New Roman font, size 12, formatted according to MLA 9th edition (for Humanities) or APA 7th edition (for Social Sciences) citation style, and in Word format.
- **Publication Scope:** Selected papers from the conference will be published in Scopus indexed journals.

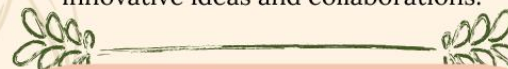
